**Chairman's report:** David Savage reported on a full and active year for Farnham Humanists. He listed some of our achievements.

- Our annual debate last November, 'Morality without religion has no firm foundation' last November.

- Summer garden party at Alan and Linda's
- Humanist walk.

David reported on members activities, progress and campaigning.

- Chaplaincy. Alec Legatt had continued his good work with Surrey Police as an associate chaplain. David asked if anyone is interested in standing in for Alec. Please contact Alec. Progress in humanist hospital chaplaincy had been disappointingly slow.

- Schools. Alan Montgomery's school talks on humanism were well received. More work in schools is planned later this year.
- Celebrants. David congratulated both celebrants who have joined Farnham Humanists and newly qualified members including: Sue Willson, Ailsa Davies and Roy Weedon.

**Treasurer's report:** Mike Adams reported that he had drawn up the account s and they had been audited by Simon Johnson.
